ANTENNA RESPONSE – SMITH CHART AND RETURN LOSS S11

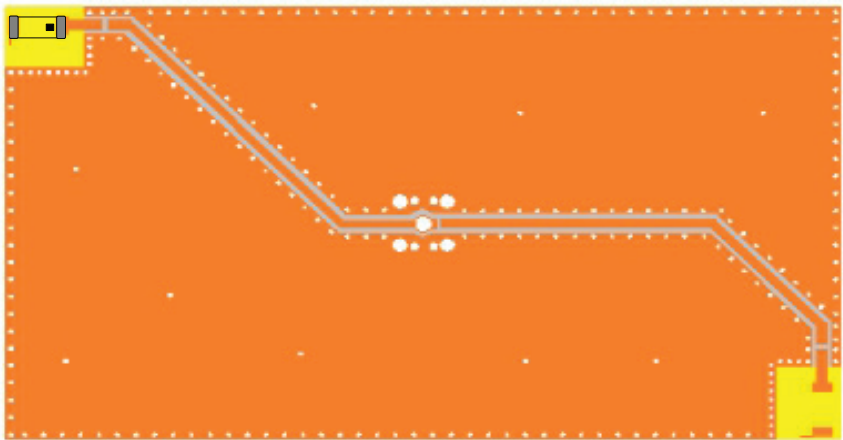
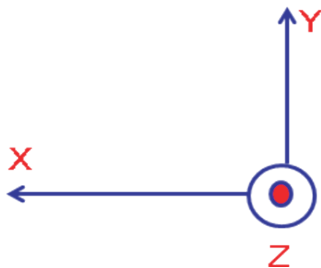


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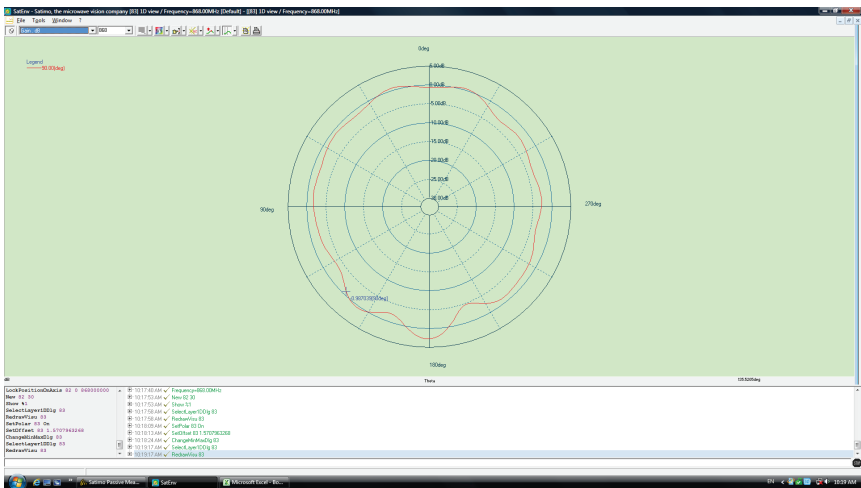
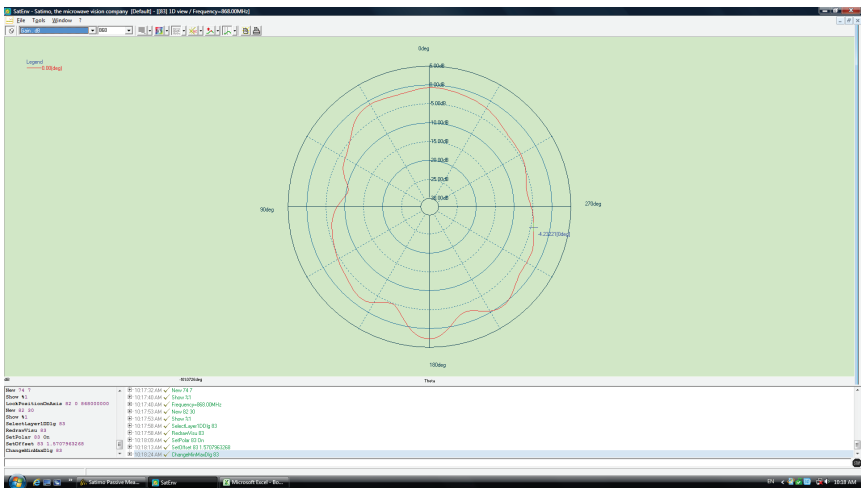

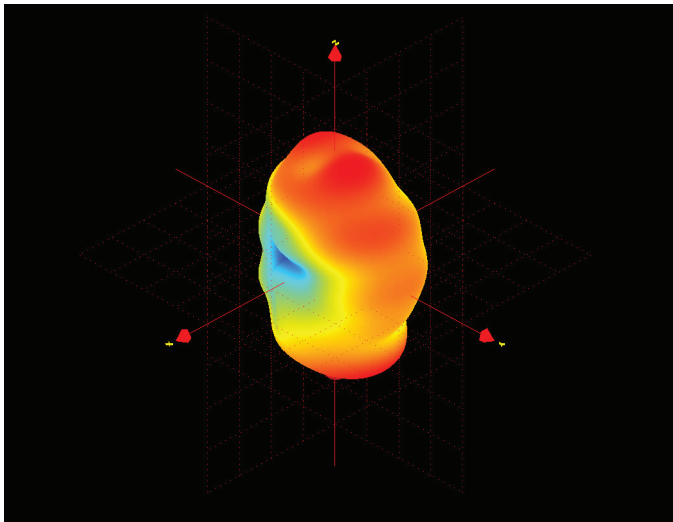
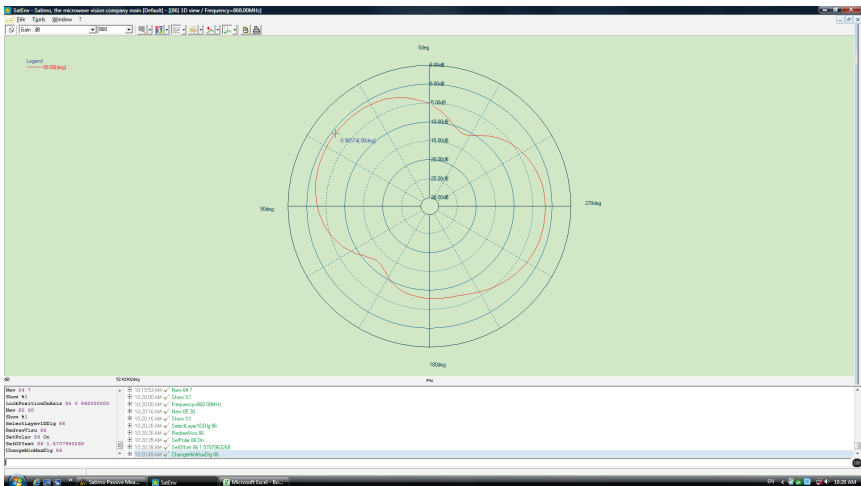


X-Z Plane
