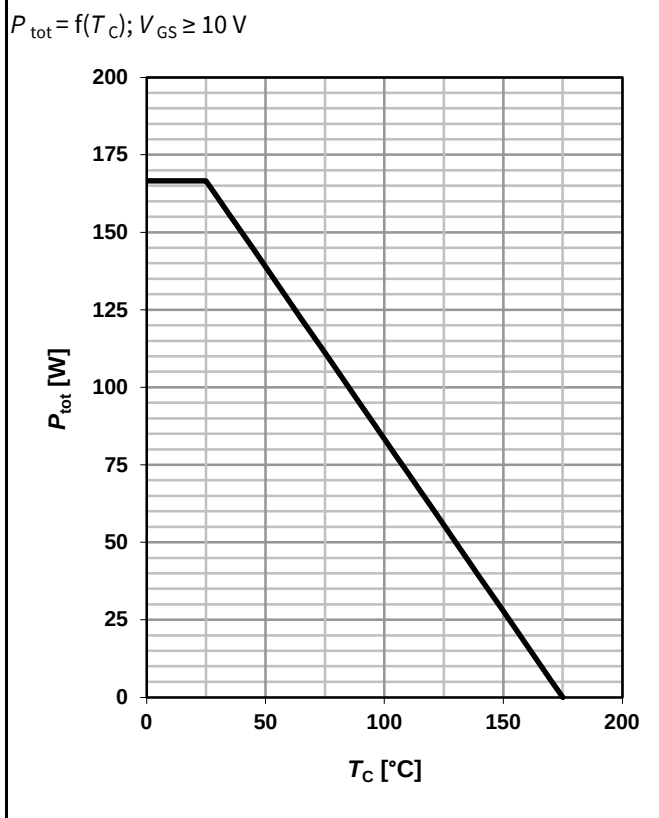

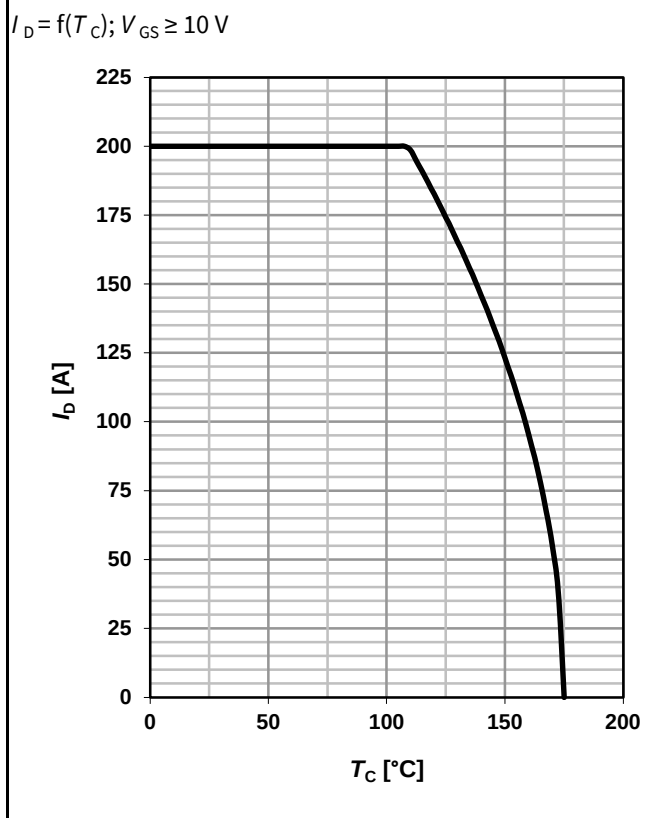

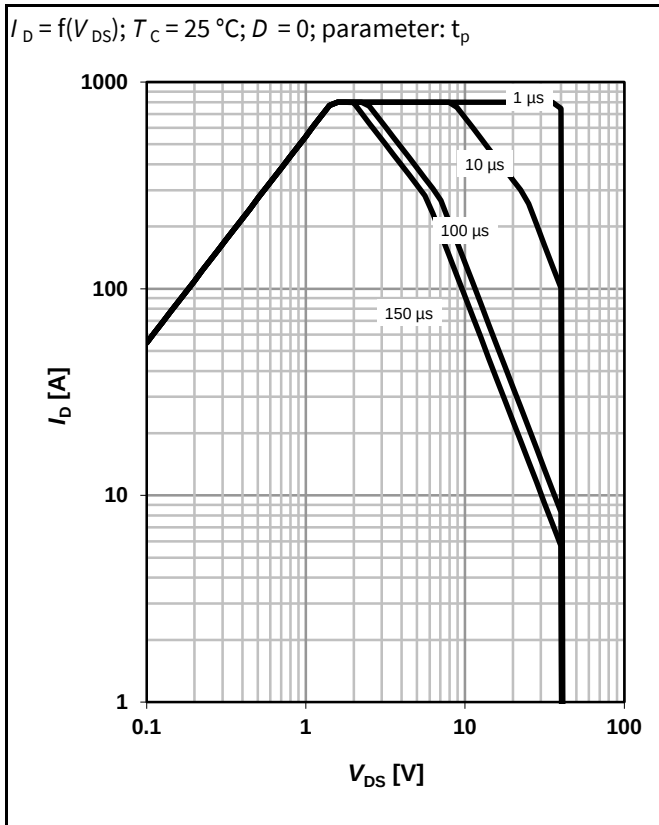
1 Power dissipation



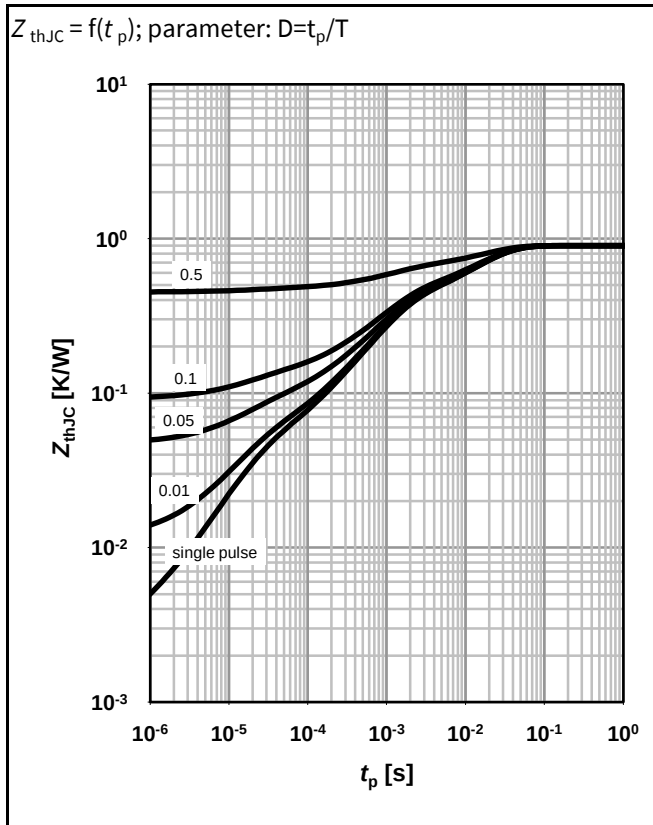
2 Drain current



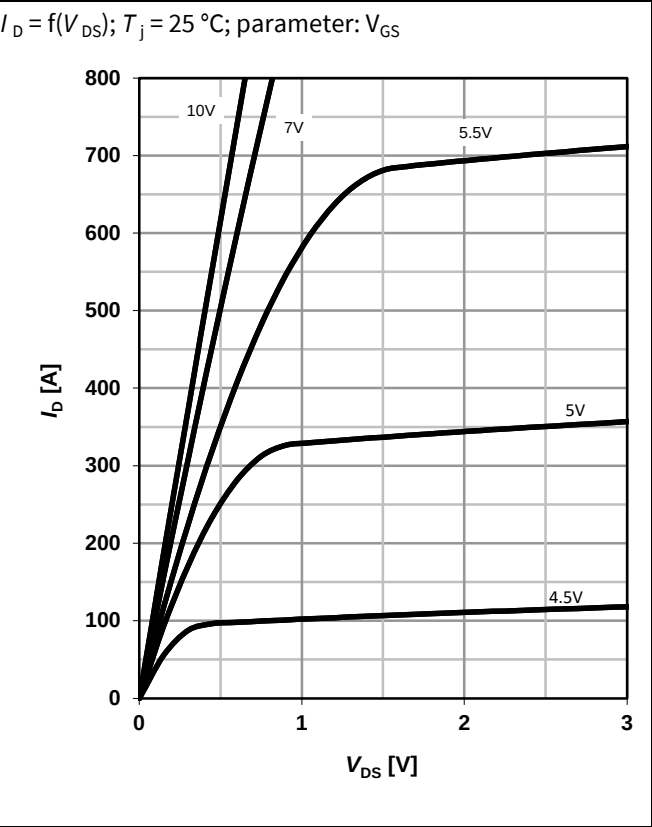
3 Safe operating area



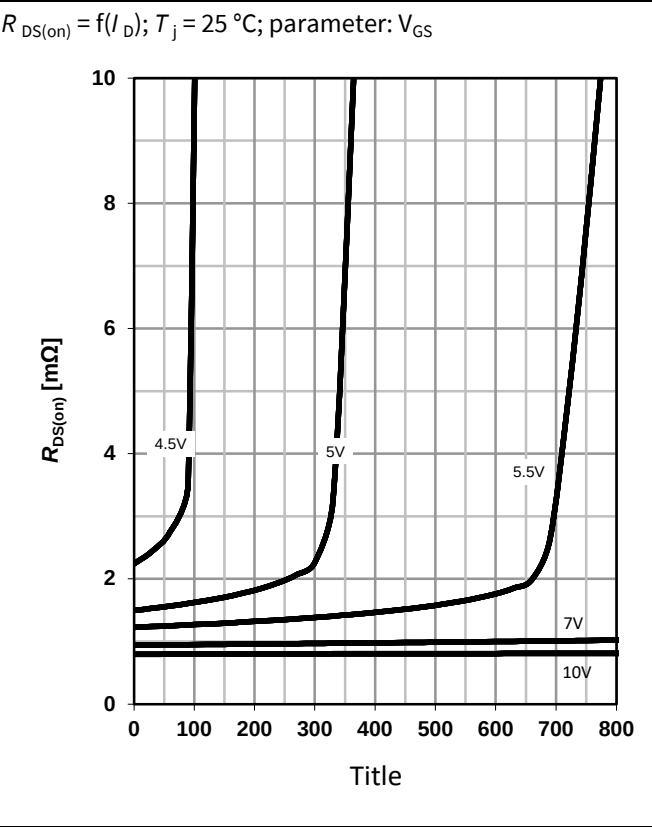
4 Max. transient thermal impedance



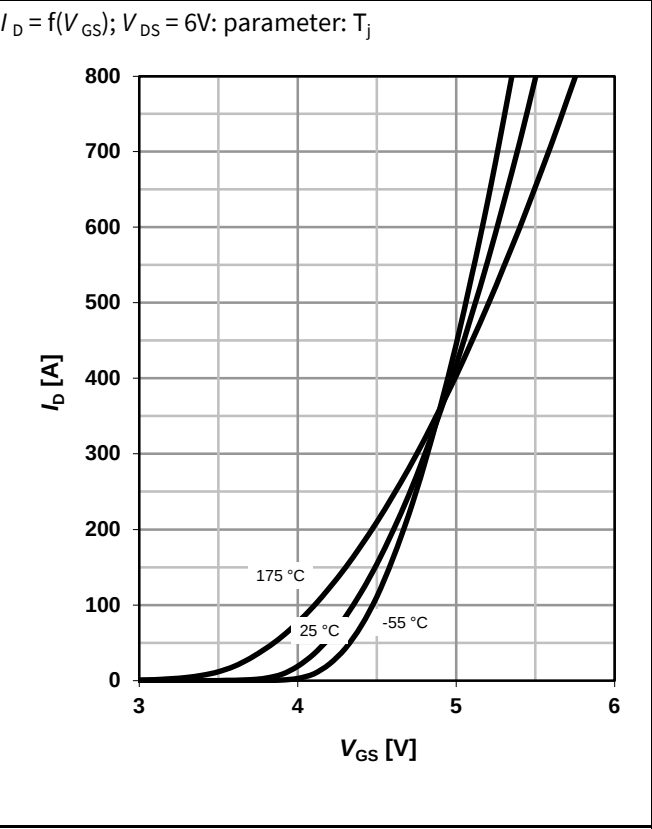
5 Typ. output characteristics



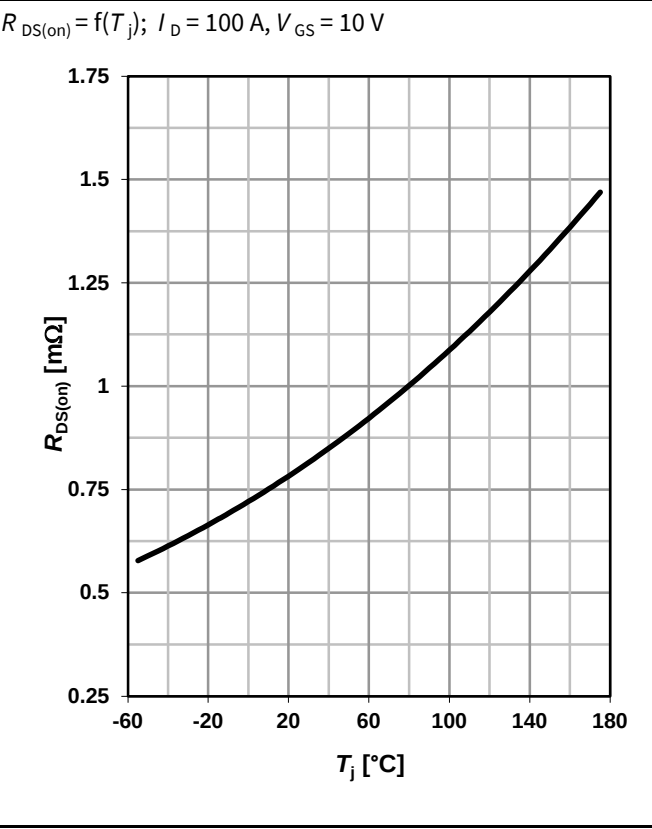
6 Typ. drain-source on-state resistance



7 Typ. transfer characteristics

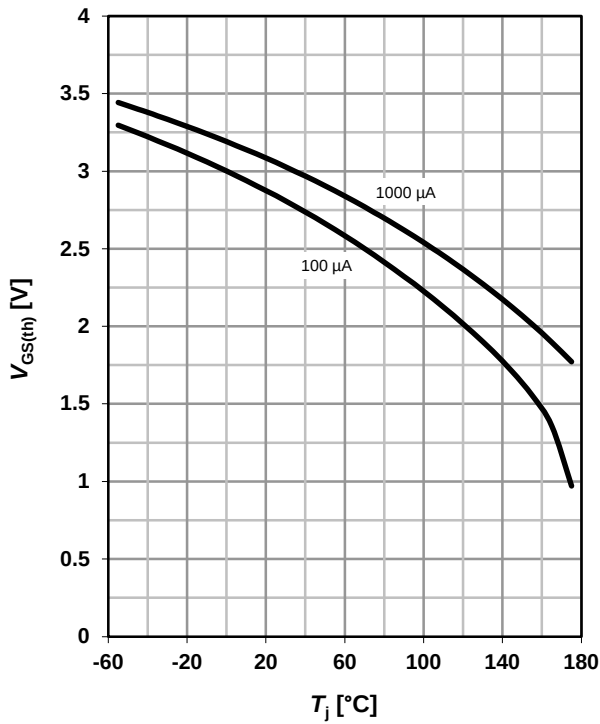


8 Typ. drain-source on-state resistance



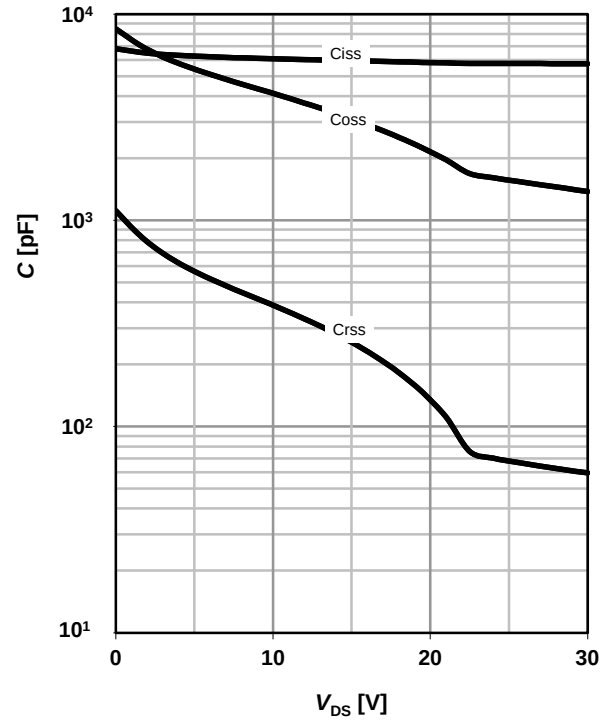
9 Typ. gate threshold voltage

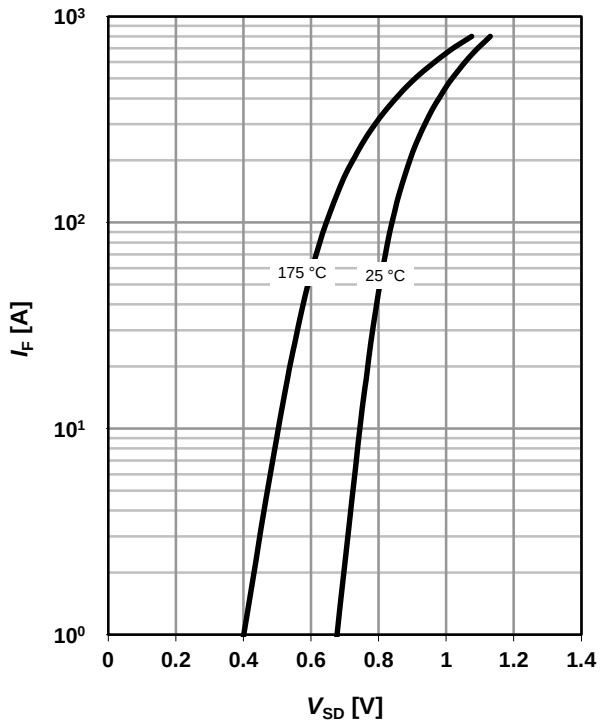
10 Typ. capacitances

$C = f(V_{DS})$; $V_{GS} = 0 V$; $f = 1 MHz$



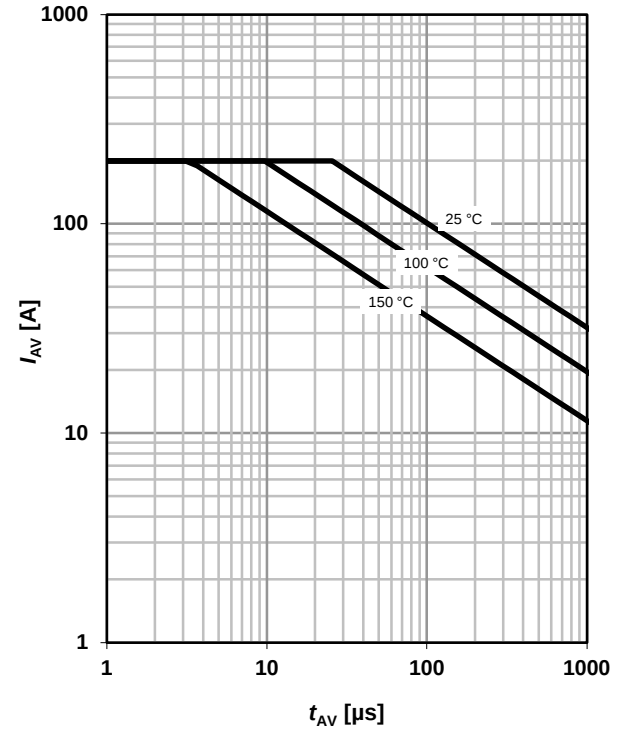
11 Typical forward diode characteristics

$I_F = f(V_{SD})$; parameter: T_j

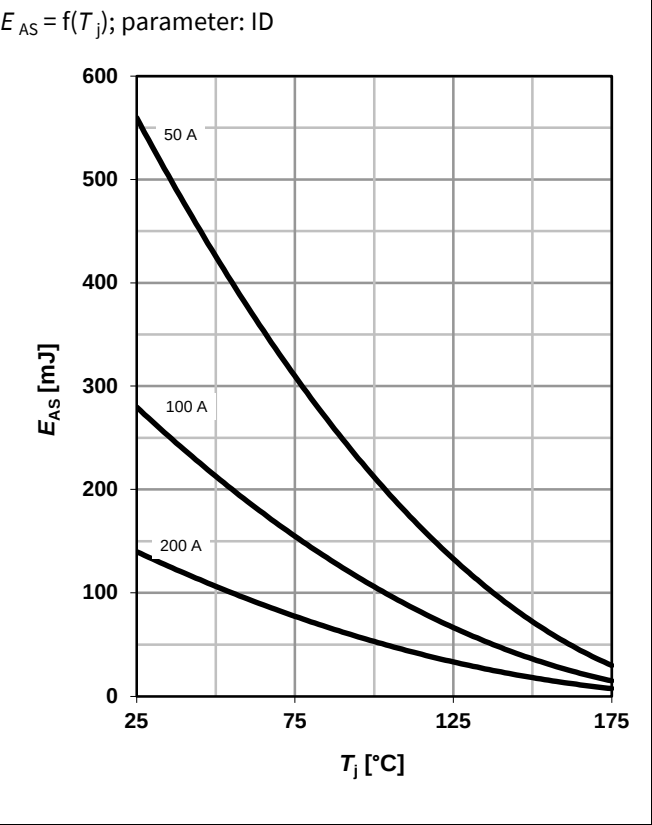


12 Typ. avalanche characteristics

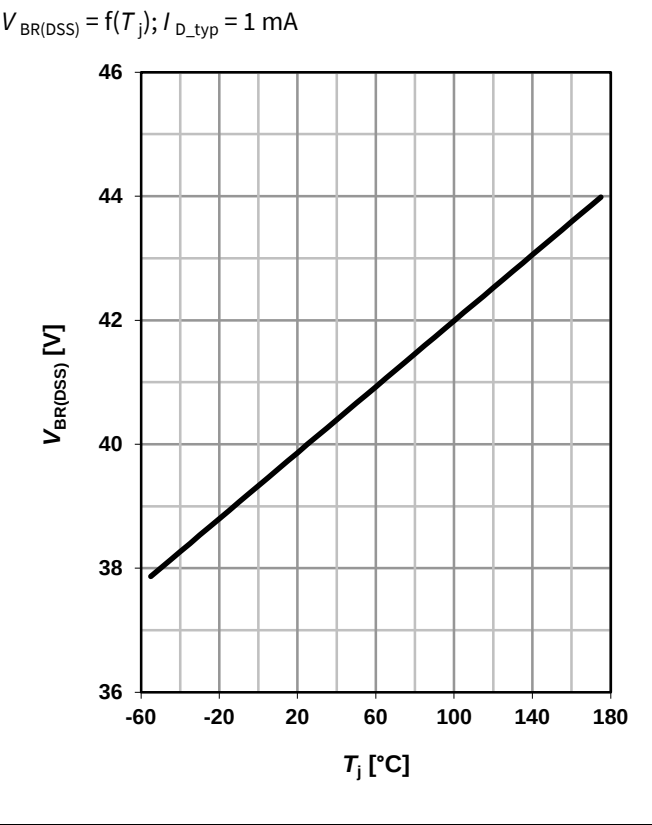
$I_{AS} = f(t_{AV})$; parameter: $T_{j(start)}$



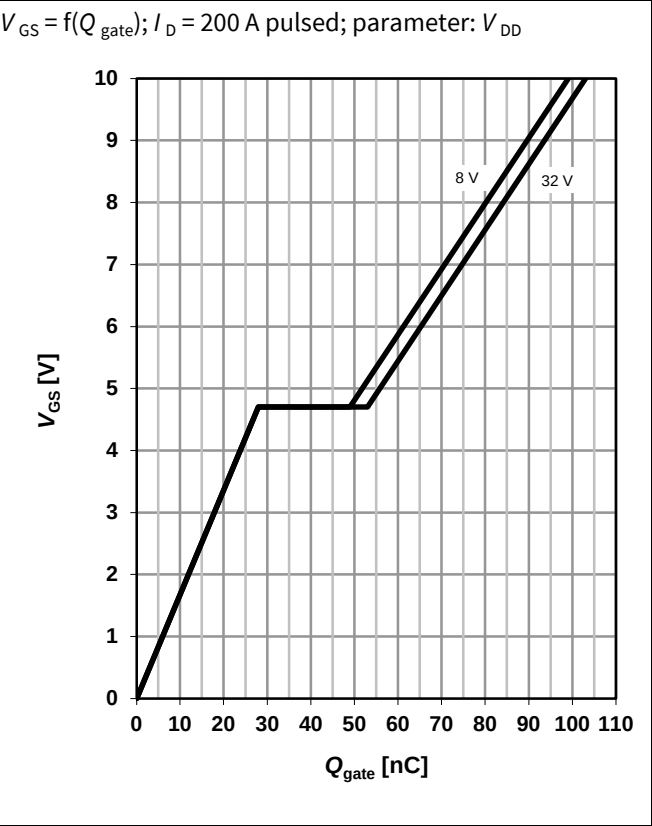
13 Typical avalanche energy



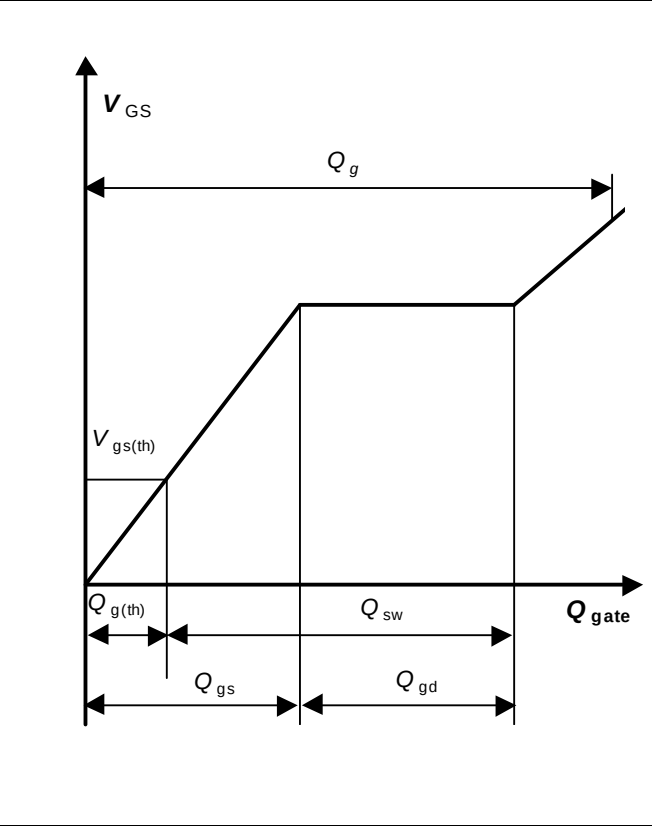
14 Drain-source breakdown voltage



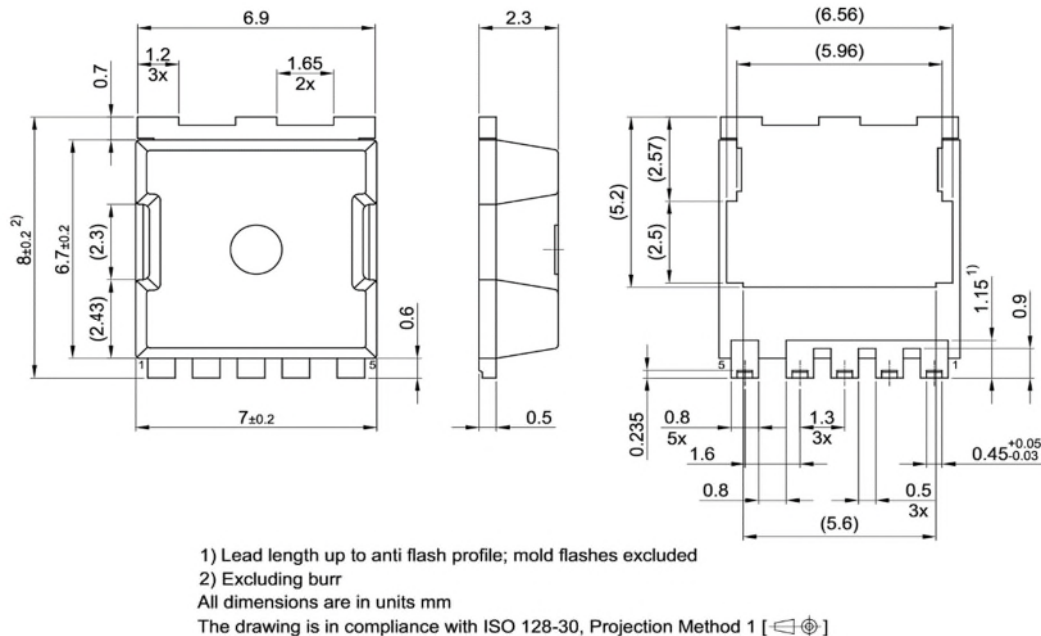
15 Typ. gate charge



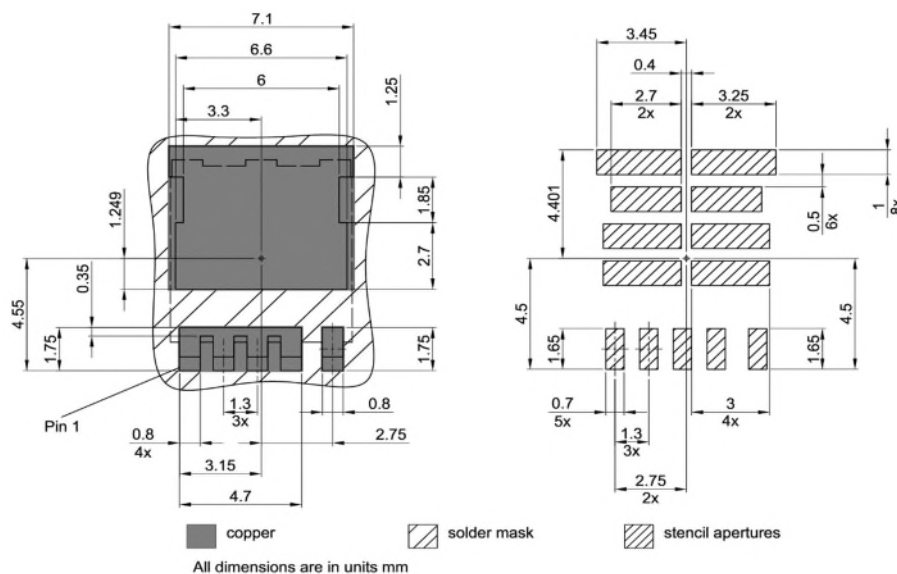
16 Gate charge waveforms



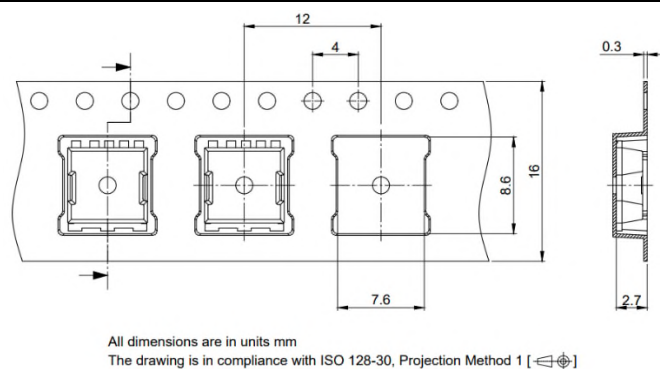
