


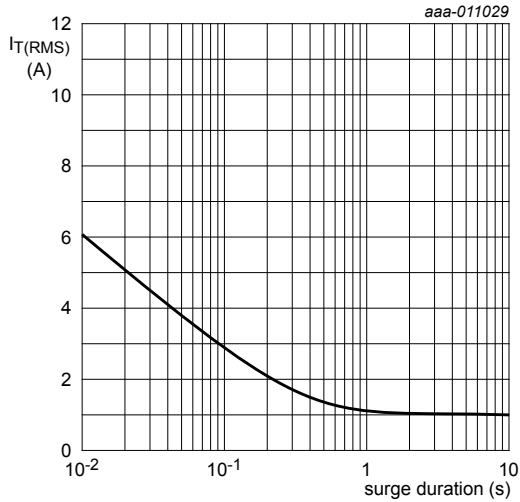

Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

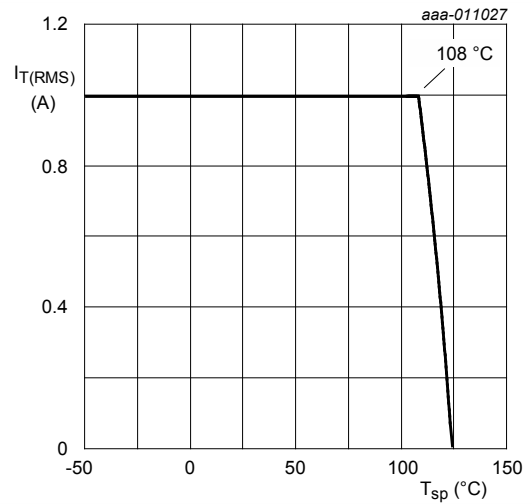
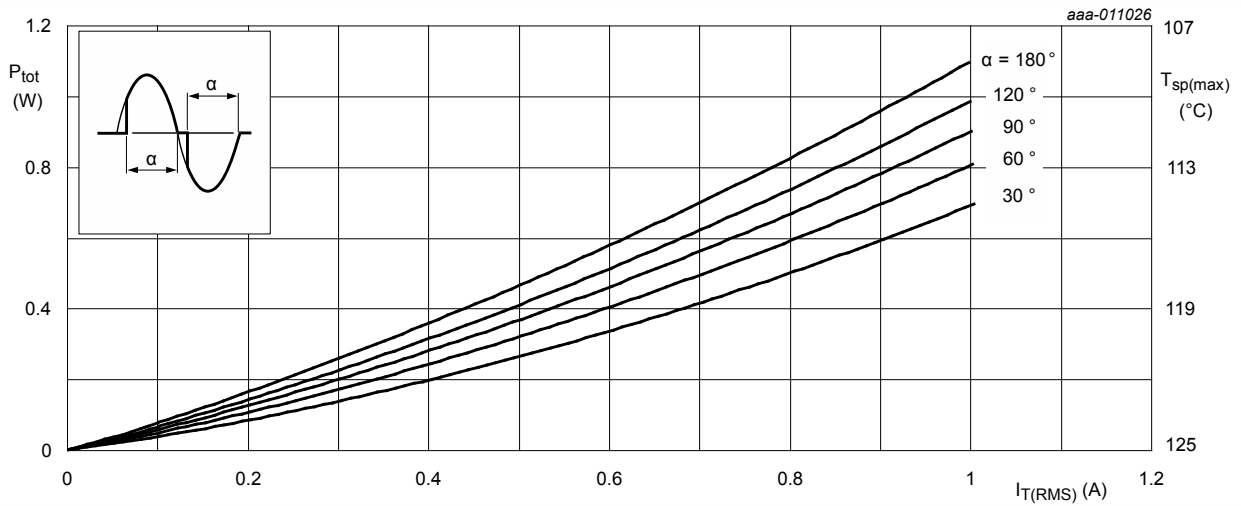


Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of solder point temperature; maximum values

Fig. 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values

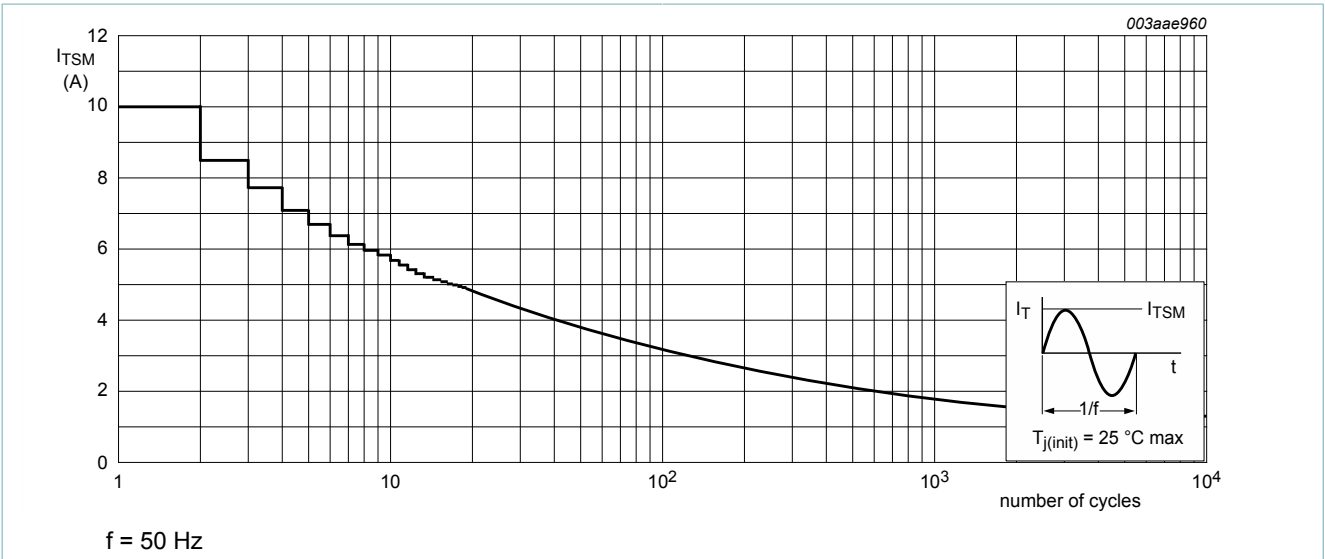


Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values

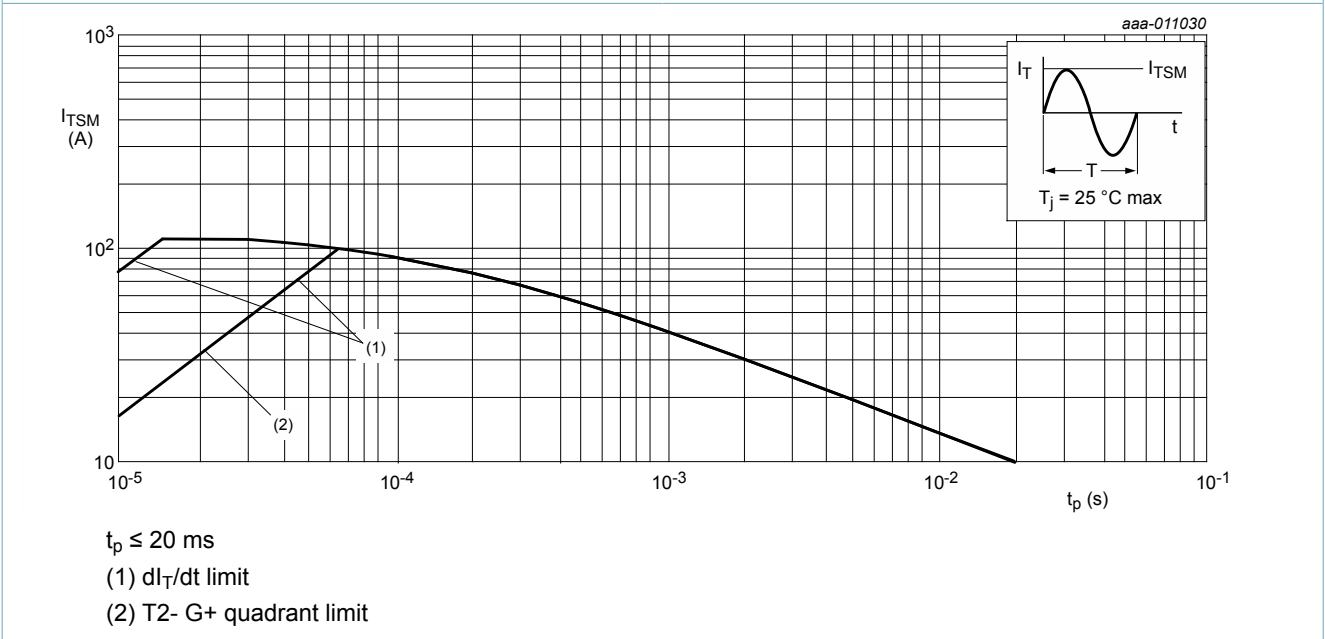


Fig. 5. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of pulse width for sinusoidal currents; maximum values

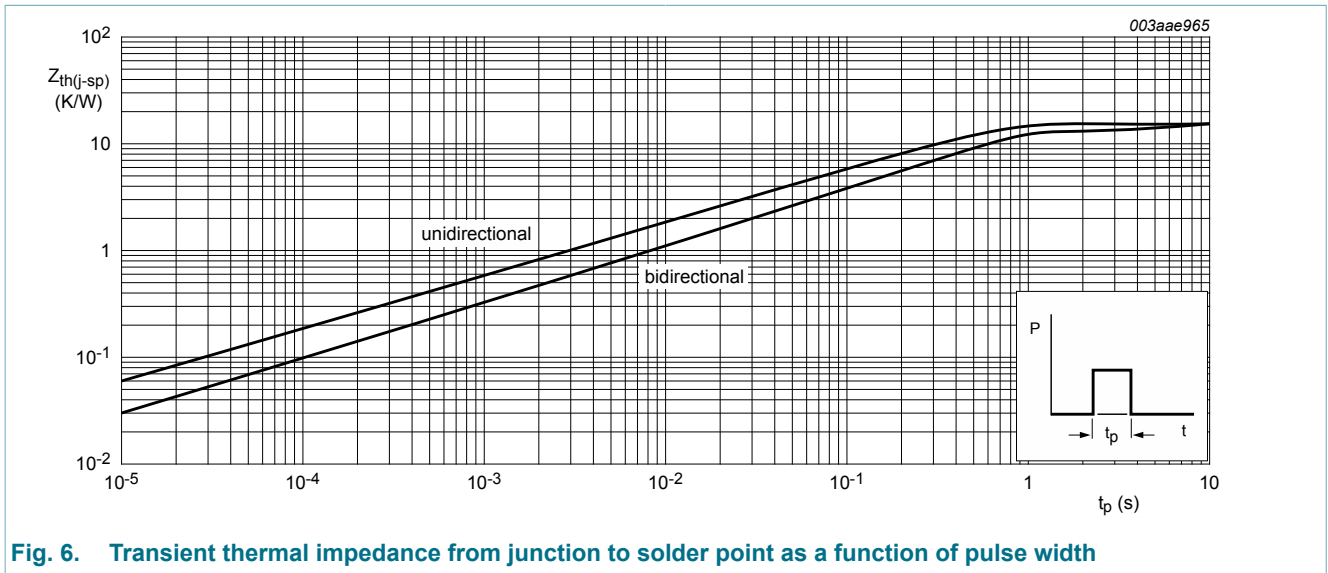


Fig. 6. Transient thermal impedance from junction to solder point as a function of pulse width

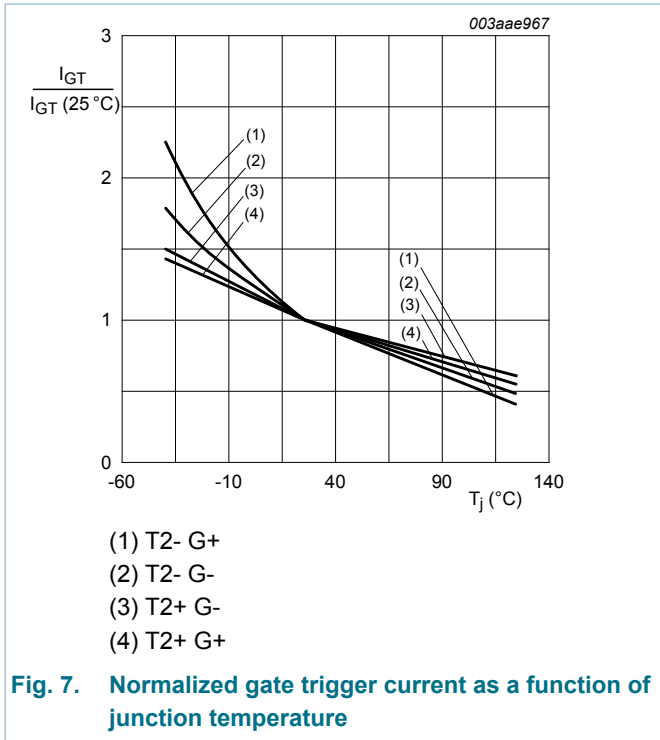


Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

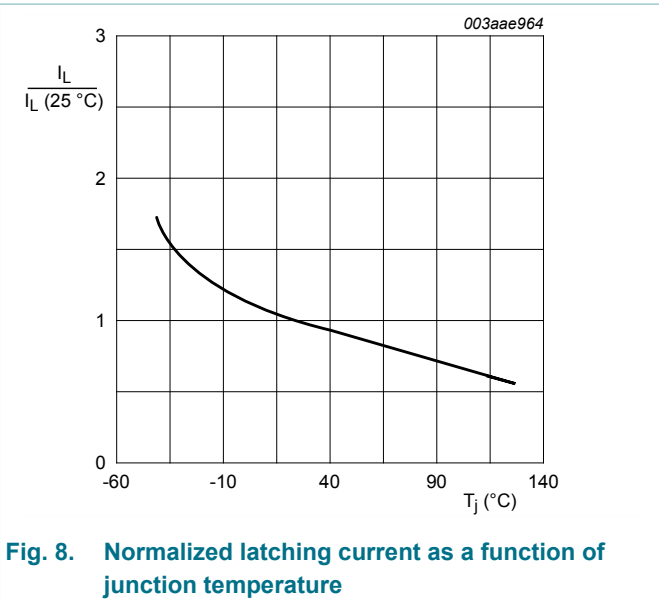


Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

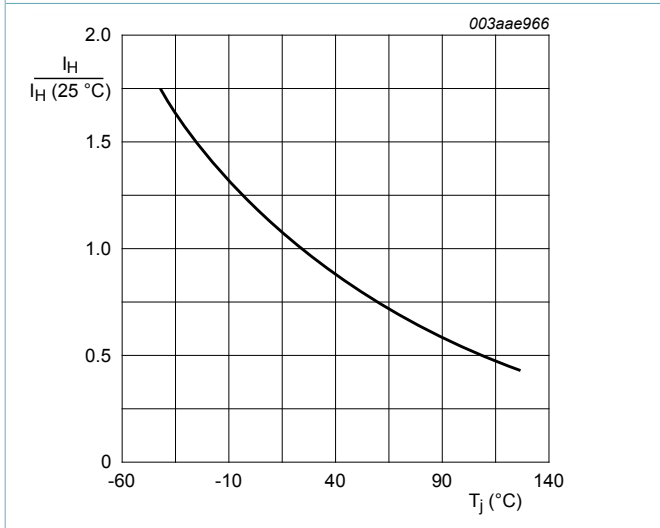


Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

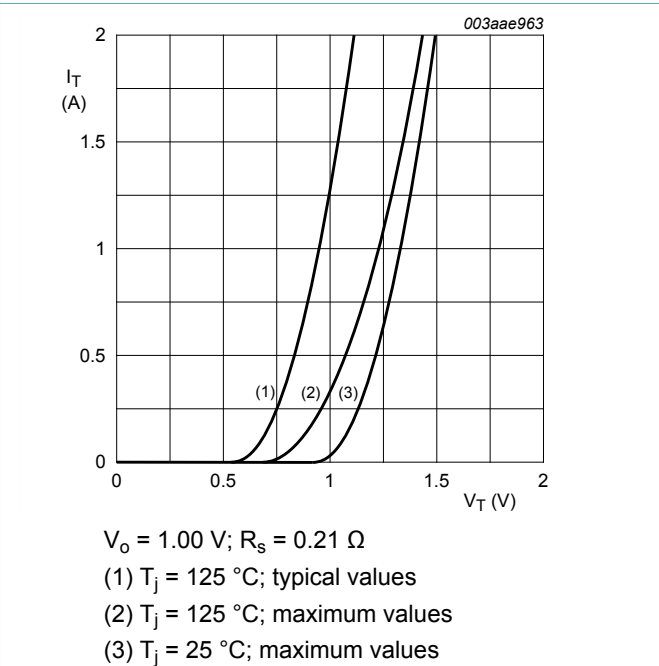


Fig. 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage

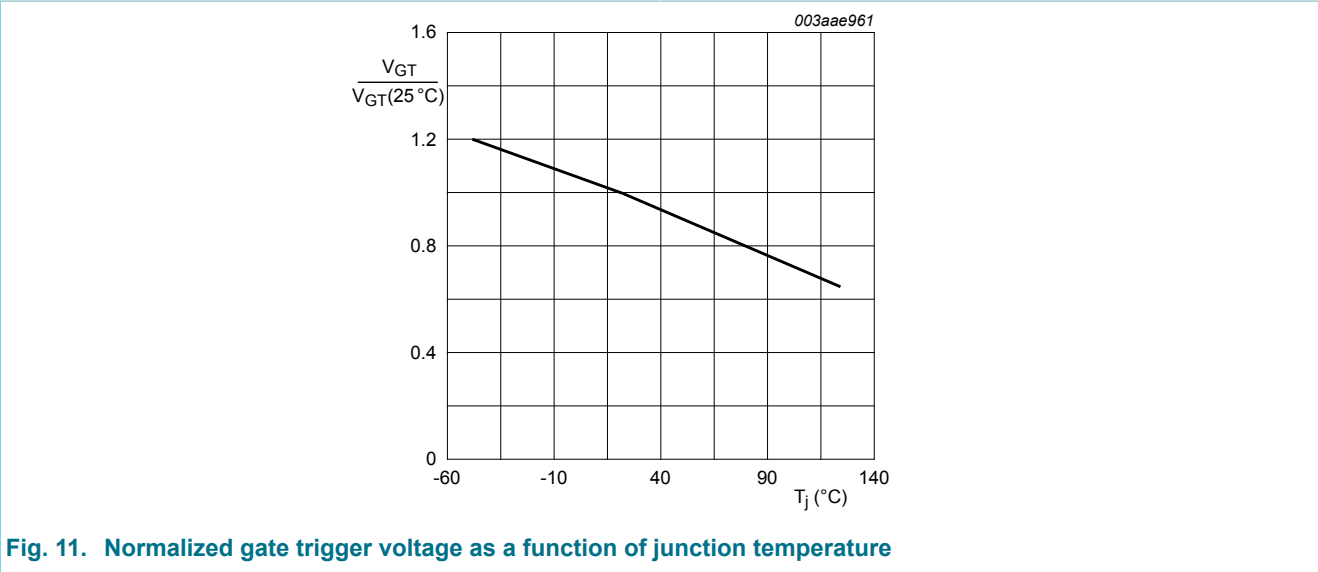


Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature

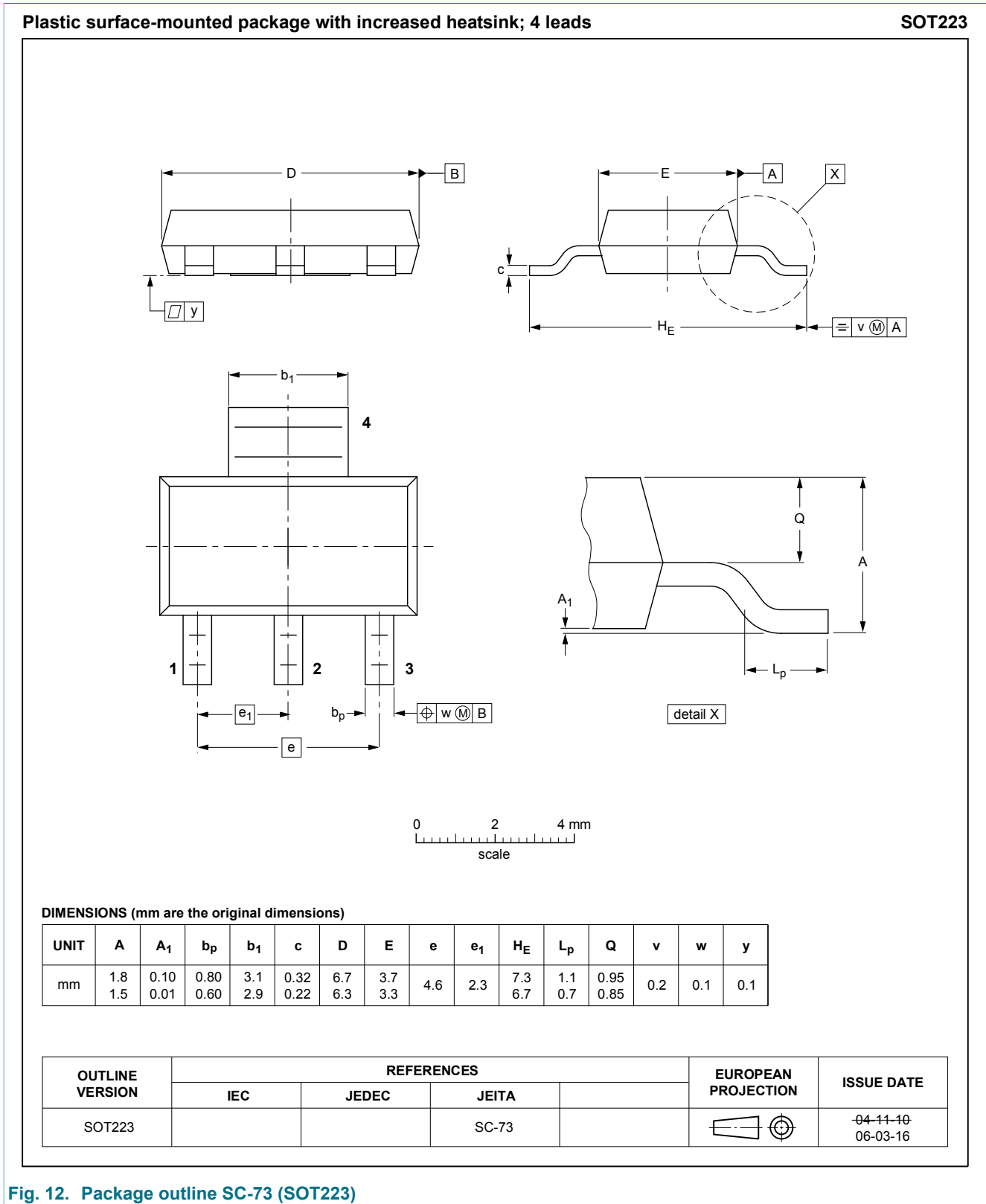


Fig. 12. Package outline SC-73 (SOT223)
