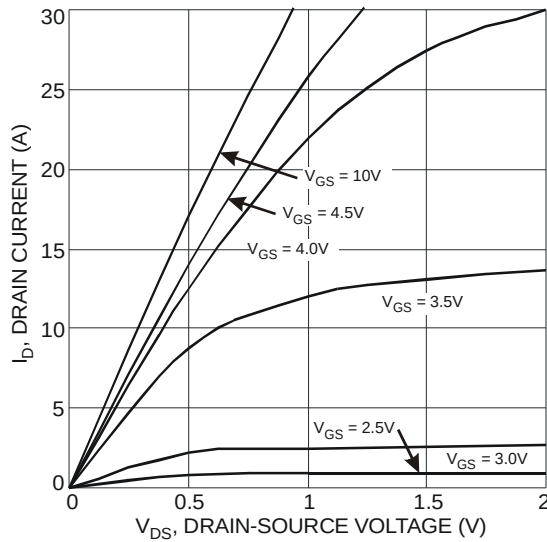


Fig. 1 Typical Output Characteristic

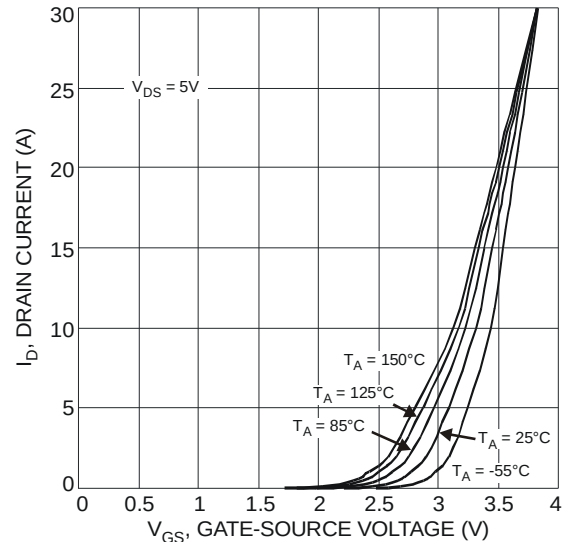


Fig. 2 Typical Transfer Characteristic

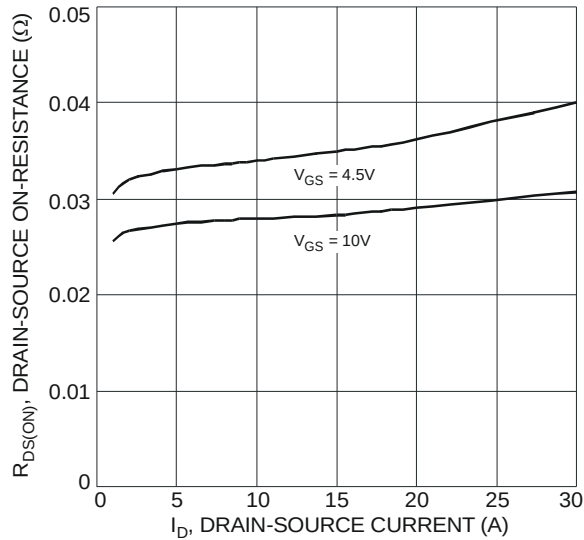


Fig. 3 Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

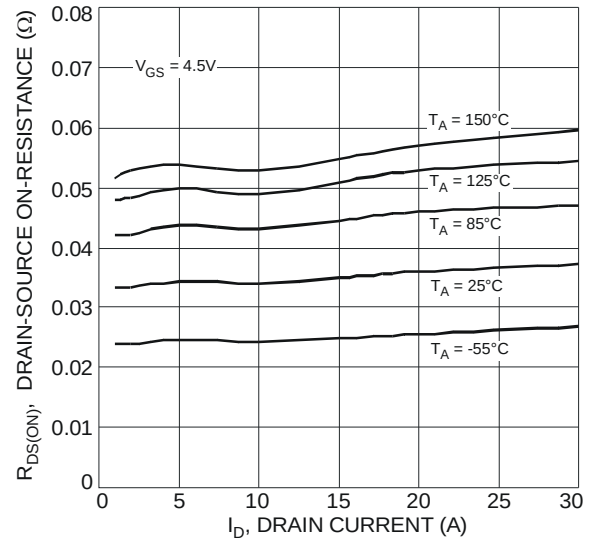


Fig. 4 Typical On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Temperature

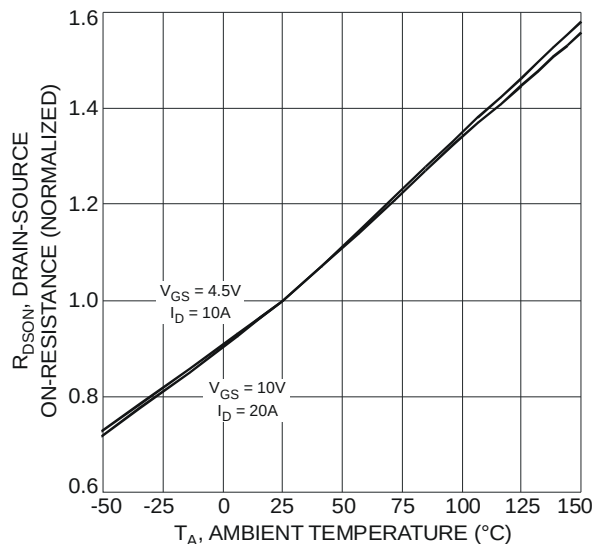


Fig. 5 On-Resistance Variation with Temperature

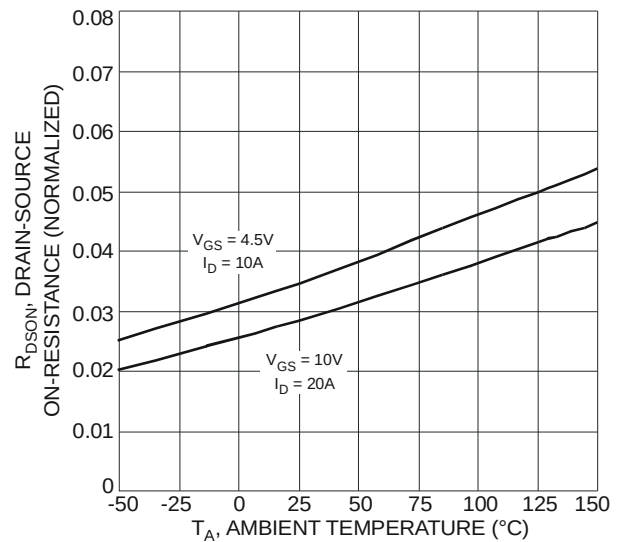


Fig. 6 On-Resistance Variation with Temperature

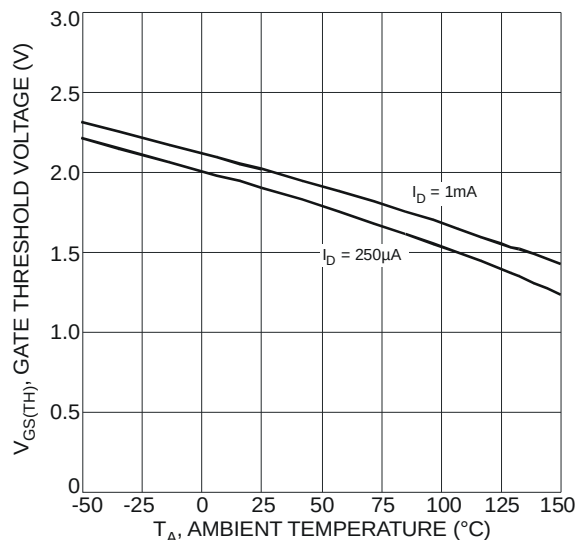


Fig. 7 Gate Threshold Variation vs. Ambient Temperature

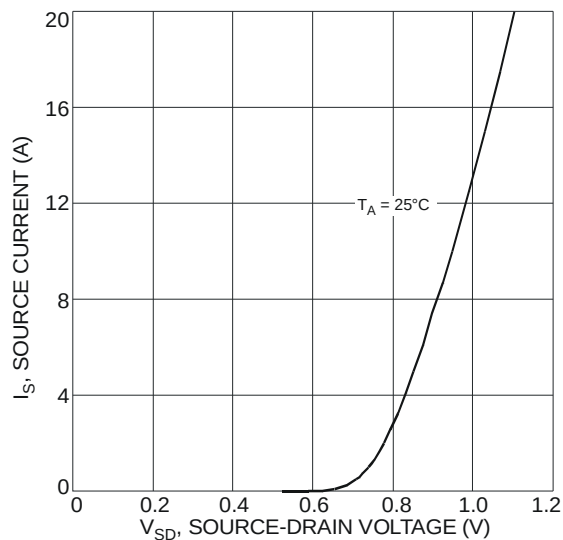


Fig. 8 Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current

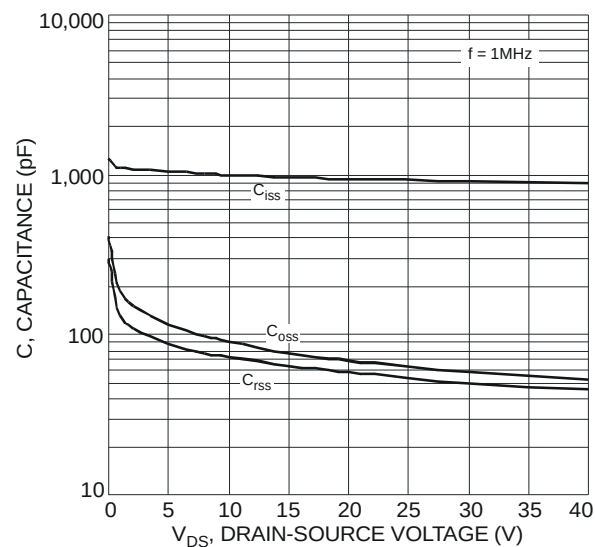


Fig. 9 Typical Total Capacitance

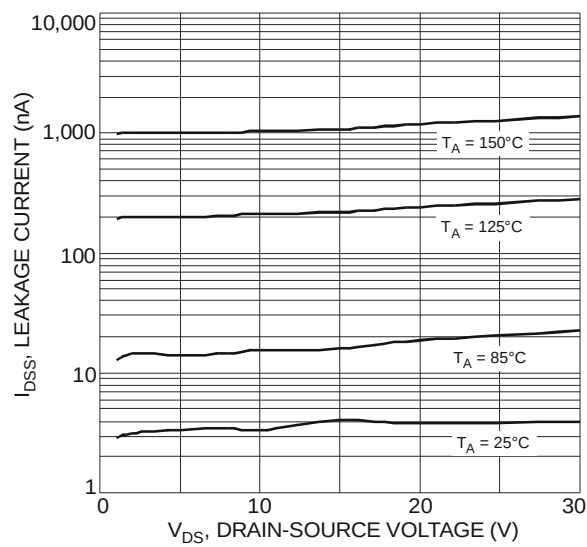


Fig. 10 Typical Leakage Current vs. Drain-Source Voltage

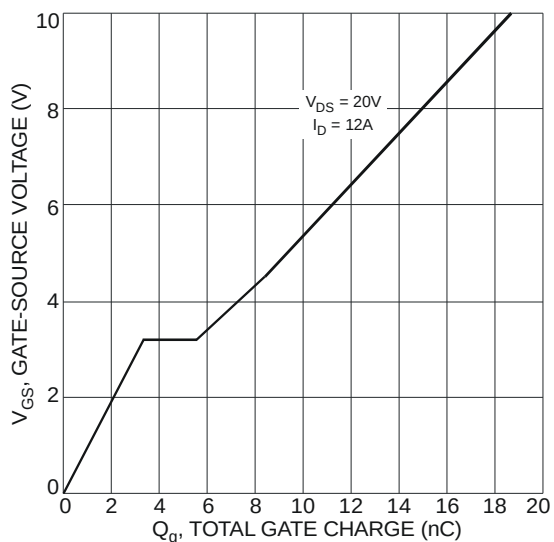


Fig. 11 Gate-Charge Characteristics

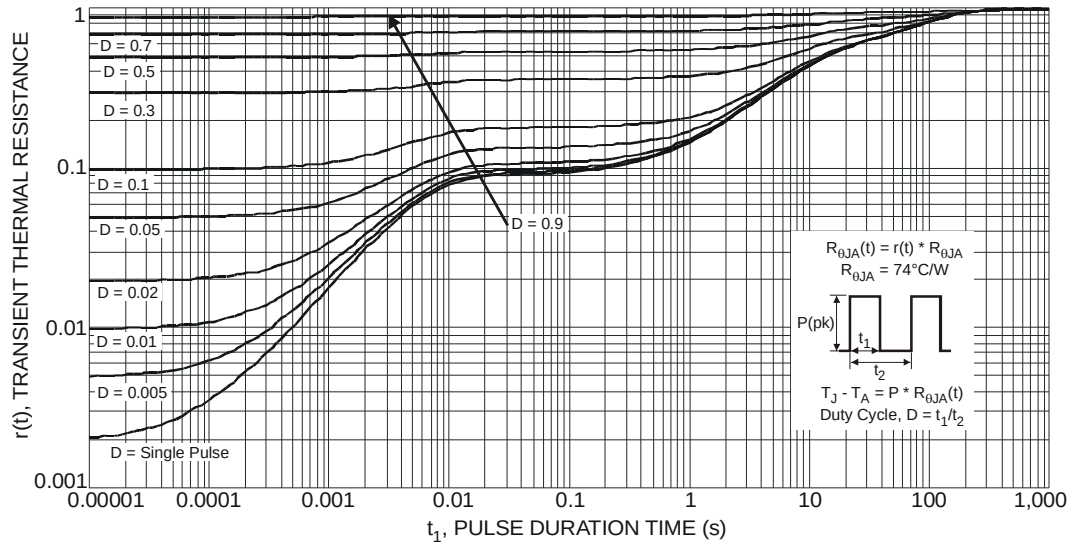
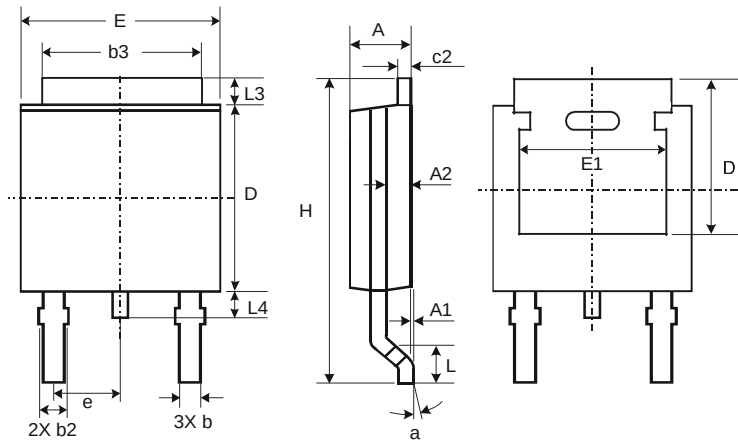


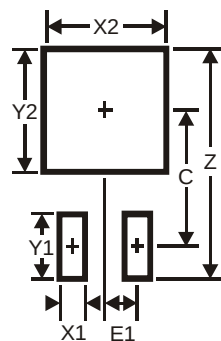
Fig. 12 Transient Thermal Response
