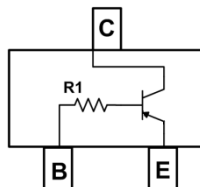

Top View



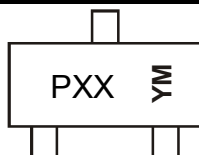
Device Schematic – Top View
